Lunch at Cumpa' Cosimo

Enjoy authentic Italian cuisine in a cozy setting.

Cost: €20-30 per person.

Tip: Try the local specialties like fresh seafood pasta or limoncello.

Visit Villa Rufolo

Villa Rufolo is one of the historic estates located in Ravello, Italy, with origins dating back to the 13th century. Enjoy the beautiful gardens and stunning views of the Amalfi Coast. The gardens of Villa Rufolo have inspired many artists and writers, including Richard Wagner, who is said to have been inspired by the villa's setting when composing his opera "Parsifal."

Time needed: 1-2 hours.

Stroll through Ravello's Historic Center

Explore the charming streets, visit local shops (specialties ceramics and cameos), and Ravello boasts surroundings that are so captivating it's likely that you'll want to spend a good deal of time lingering in them. The town square - Piazza Vescovado is the perfect spot for doing just that. Housing Ravello Cathedral, the entrance to Villa Rufolo and a clattering of cafes and bars along its edges, the town square is the perfect spot to grab a coffee/gelato/wine and soak it all in.

Cost: Free.

Time needed: 1-2 hours plus

Visit Villa Cimbrone

Perched on a cliff high above the Amalfi Coast, Villa Cimbrone dates back to the 11th century when it was originally a fortified dwelling. Explore the historic villa and its breathtaking gardens. Look for the Terrace of Infinity is a famous belvedere within the garden, offering panoramic views over the Mediterranean.

Entrance fee: €7-10.

Time needed: 1-2 hours

Profumi della Costiera

Nestled amongst the winding lanes of Ravello is this little limoncello producer. Made with the gigantic local lemons that are particular to the area, known as sfusato amalfitano, lemons are peeled by hand before being infused with alcohol to create delicious limoncello.
