For Gina and Richie

Centro Storico (historic city center) Stroll

- Head into the old town right after check-in and do a relaxed wander through narrow lanes, small shops, and church squares.
- Aim for a “loop” rather than a straight line—have a quick gelato/coffee/aperitivo and just follow the lanes you find interesting.
- Your hotel can offer their best street suggestion. I like Via del Prione as it goes all the way to the marina.

Museo Tecnico Navale (Naval Museum)

- Use this as an indoor break from the heat and/or the rain.
- Easy to navigate naval history museum with cannons, small model ships, and other military arsenal that supported the port and commerce of La Spezia into WWII history.

Castello San Giorgio for sunset views

- Climbing the Saint George Staircase will take you to the eponymous castle, a 13th-century fortress overlooking the town.
- For a small fee you can go inside for an eclectic mix of prehistoric and medieval artifacts.
- But the panoramic views alone are worth the trek.
