# What to See

## **Orvieto Cathedral (Duomo di Orvieto)**

A stunning example of Italian Gothic architecture, the Orvieto Cathedral is renowned for its intricate facade and beautiful frescoes inside.

## **Orvieto Underground**

Explore the fascinating network of caves and tunnels beneath the city, which were used for thousands of years as cellars, cisterns, and even escape routes.

## **Pozzo di San Patrizio (St. Patrick's Well)**

This impressive well was built in the 16th century and features a double helix staircase, allowing mules to carry water up and down without interfering with each other.

## **Orvieto's Etruscan Necropolis**

Visit the ancient Etruscan burial grounds located just outside the city, where you can explore tombs carved into the rock and learn about the fascinating Etruscan civilization.

## **Orvieto's Palazzo del Popolo**

This medieval palace houses the Faina Museum, which exhibits a rich collection of Etruscan artifacts, medieval and Renaissance art, and archaeological finds.

## **Orvieto's St. Andrew's Church**

Admire the beautiful Romanesque architecture of this historic church, which also houses a number of important frescoes and other works of art.

## **Orvieto's Albornozi Fortress**
