#### **Orvieto Cathedral (Duomo di Orvieto)**

A stunning example of Italian Gothic architecture, the Orvieto Cathedral is renowned for its intricate facade and beautiful frescoes inside.

#### **Orvieto Underground**

#### Pozzo di San Patrizio (St. Patrick's Well)

This impressive well was built in the 16th century and features a double helix staircase, allowing mules to carry water up and down without interfering with each other.

#### **Orvieto's Etruscan Necropolis**
